CHILD PROTECTION POLICY INFORMATION FOR: YOUNG PEOPLE

You can expect:

- You have the right to be safe.
- We will take action to prevent you from being harmed.
- Leaders will listen to your concerns.





What can you report?

- A problem at home, school, church, or elsewhere.
- Something a friend has said and you are worried about someone's safety or wellbeing.
- If you feel unsafe at any time, with anyone.
- Something has happened to you that you know is wrong, whether at home, at school, in the community or within any church program.

You can speak up, no matter who is involved.





Ways you can let us know about concerns you have:



- Tell your Parent, Guardian or Carer and have them speak to a church leader.
- Tell a church/youth leader yourself.

- You can bring a support person with you if this will help you.
