



CHILD PROTECTION POLICY INFORMATION FOR: PARENTS, GUARDIANS & CARERS

You can expect:

- Your child has the right to be safe.
- We will take action to prevent your child from being harmed.
- Leaders will listen to you or your child's concerns, and take them seriously.



You can report if:

- You have a concern about what is going on at home, school, church, or elsewhere.
- You have a friend who has told you something and you are concerned about a child's safety or wellbeing.
- Your child tells you something and you are concerned for their, or another child's safety or wellbeing.
- You have received information about abuse or have knowledge of inappropriate behaviour of a parent, your child or their peers, or anyone at church including staff.

You should be confident to report your concern, no matter who is involved.

- We are committed to communicating with you about your child's wellbeing and safety.
- We are committed to meeting all legal reporting requirements and never covering up any allegations made against someone in leadership.
